

Tremblers Traveling Team



This is to advise the player and the parents of the few rules the Tremblers traveling team uses. **The first is to advise that the daughter and parent named on this form have been notified of these rules and have read and agreed to these rules.**

All of the PV TREMBLERS Travel Ball teams will be performance-based in regards to playing time. Being “Performance-Based” requires players to be fully committed to attending all practices and tournaments while adhering to all ASA rules. The coaching staff of each team determines playing time and positioning based on practice and tournament performance. These guidelines are used to keep teams competitive and to achieve team goals. Everyone will not get equal playing time.

Players will be played at the appropriate time decided by the Manager or Coach of the team. If a parent needs to speak to the Manager or Coach, this will be done at an appropriate time (NOT DURING A GAME). All coaches do their best to find enough playing time for everyone so all the players on the team get enough game experience, but there is never a guarantee that playing time will be equal. You must earn your time on the field by performing well in practices and then matching that performance in tournament situations.

There will be more practices than league and you could be benched for tournament games for being a “no show” at practice. What this means is that you could sit on the bench for an entire game or games. The Tremblers play by different rules and regulations than league. The practices are more intense since the teams we will be playing against very competitive teams.

Once again, this is a very competitive time for softball and the cooperation of players and parents will be needed.

Tremblers play several weekends during the summer. Anywhere from 4 to 8 weekends from May to August depending on the Manager of the team. The fee to play Tremblers is between \$250.00 to \$600.00 per person (depends on age division). A deposit of \$150.00 is made by the first practice and the remainder before the first Tournament. This deposit is needed to purchase the uniforms and first tournament. The parents are responsible for the hotel cost if the team has an overnight stay out of town. This again depends on the Manager of the team. The Manager picks his/her own tournaments to go to. If the deposit is not paid, your daughter could be benched or the uniform could be held until the deposit is made or arrangements made with the Trembler Manager/Team mom.

Uniform consist of..... two shirts, Pants, two socks. This may change depending on team.
