

DRAFT RULES

- 1) Draft order is determined by drawing a number out of a hat.
- 2) Draft order is serpentine. (ex. 1st round is 1-6, 2nd round #6 picks 1st, then #5, #4, etc.)
- 3) Personal Rule: If for some reason or personal conflict there is a girl who you refuse to have on your team, this must be stated at the beginning of the draft. If that girl is one of the last two to be chosen and you have last pick, the second to the last person must take her.
- 4) Daughter Option:
 - 7-12 year olds: All managers' and coaches' daughters will be picked in third, fifth and seventh rounds of the draft, unless the player is a top round pick. Coaches will vote on the round to place them in.
 - 13-18 year olds: All "option players" are seeded by the other coaches as to which round of the draft they are to be picked in. If that coach does not select that girl in the round designated by the other coaches, she is available to be selected by another coach.

Note: this rule only applies to other relatives if the coach does not have a daughter playing in this division.
- 5) Sister Option: If you pick one of two (or more) sisters that must play together on the same team you must pick the other sister two rounds later. (example: You pick one sister in the 3rd round, the other sister must be picked in the 5th round.)
- 6) Jumping Divisions: For safety of a player, this league will not allow a player to jump two divisions. Example: 9 year old wanting to move to 14 & under, they can move one division but not two. (03-2005)
- 7) If a player would like to move up a division. She will need to go to both try out age groups. Example.....A 10 year old would like to play 12 & under. She will need to go to 10 & under try outs and 12 & under try outs. (new 2011)
- 8) If a player is considered a safety issue in a division the coaches can drop the player down one age group. The player can play part of the season down then be pulled back up after players skills are shown not to be a safety issue and there is room to move back up.
- 9) Players will be selected by oldest division first then next lower division and so on. Example..... first 14U then 12U etc. This is so the older players are selected first and to fill the coaching staff at the seasons time. Example.....If only two coaches then we can only select for two teams. The youngest or safety players to move down and to follow #8 above.
